Did a family member recently call you because they were **arrested**?

Did a lawyer or police officer tell you to **withdraw cash** to **pay a loved one's bail**?

Were you told to put the **cash in an envelope** and wait for a **courier** to pick it up?

Did the person on the phone mention something about:

- Someone arrested for impaired driving?
- Someone arrested for drugs?
- A car accident?
- Finding a gun in the car?
- A pregnant woman?
- A gag order?

Fraudsters are using these stressful situations to convince you to give them money.
